Road Travel Safety Tips

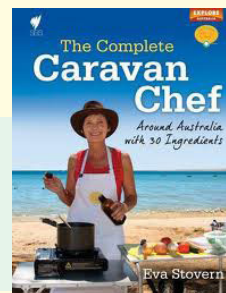
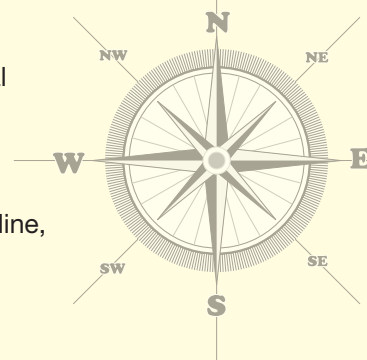
An industry representative will be on hand to advise about safe towing and avoiding common travel problems on the road.
