The gallery will present this professional development day for teachers in line with themes of the exhibition *Made in China, Australia*, as they relate to the Cultural Frame and notions of how cultural identity can inform the production of artworks.

The day's program will feature a contemporary Chinese- Australian artist from the exhibition and a representative from DET. They will be joined by Hunter-based art educator, Carol Carter, winner of the NSW Premier's Contemporary Art Scholarship in 2011, who will present the project for which she received the scholarship, *Contemporary Photomedia in China*. The project and resulting website were developed during 2012 through research and travel in China 'to study the use of photomedia in contemporary Chinese art and its relevance to the critical study of contemporary art practice by senior secondary students.'
