- **Due to WHS issues, all participants must wear appropriate clothing and footwear. Participants will not be allowed to enter a class wearing thongs or open-toed footwear.**

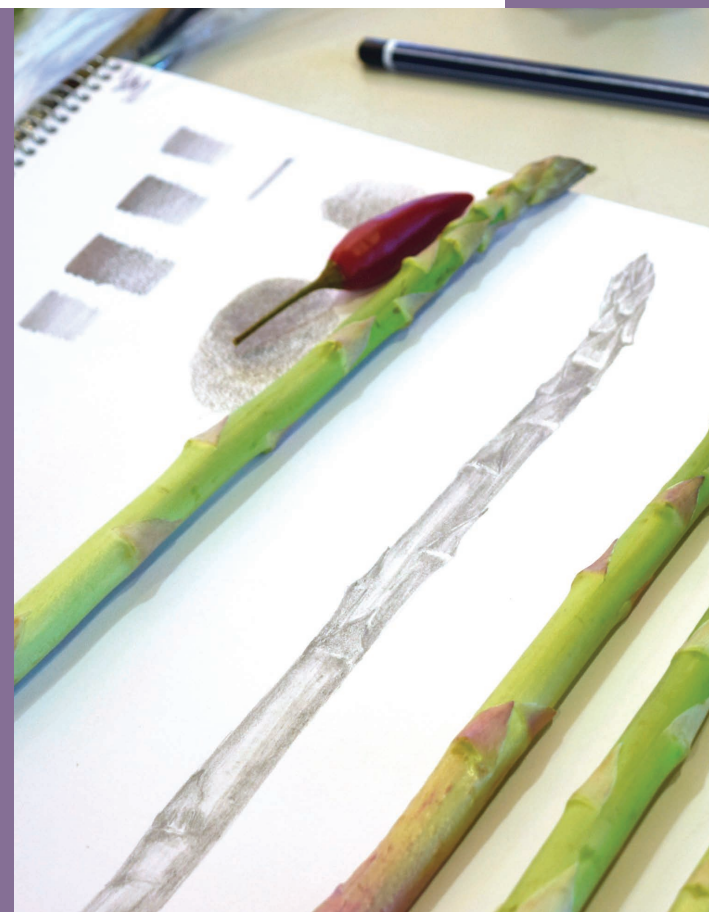

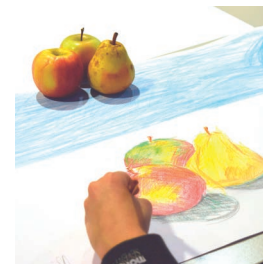

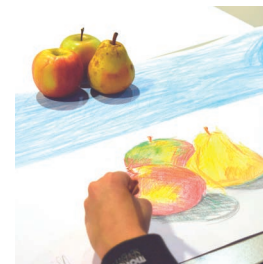
